About this report


At Healthwatch Norfolk we have been hearing concerns from residents about access to dental services for several years and have seen a significant increase in the last year. This is something we have raised with NHS England and NHS Improvement (NHSE/I), Health overview and Scrutiny Committee (HOSC) and the local press (see appendix 1).

This report highlights the signposting queries we have received regarding dental services in Norfolk since January 2020 and the information people have been requesting regarding dental services. It also details reviews of dental practices our engagement team have collected, and investigations carried out by the Healthwatch Norfolk team into dentist's website and the availability of dental practices taking on new NHS patients.

Signposting queries relating to dental services

From January to September 2020, we have received 119 signposting queries asking for information on how to access dental services in Norfolk. In comparison, we only received 16 dentist enquiries from January to September 2019. These figures include enquiries from people looking for emergency treatment and people looking for an ongoing dentist.





The graph below shows the number of dental enquiries since January 2020.

As you can see from the graph, the number of enquiries reduced while dental practices were closed during the COVID-19 pandemic and then significantly increased once they opened again mid-June. This may not signify that the demand decreased when dental practices were closed but simply that patients understood they were unable to deliver the necessary services due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Details of dental enquiries

We have heard from a variety of people from across Norfolk about their difficulties finding an NHS dentist (see appendix 2). This has included people looking for emergency treatment but unable to access an appointment after contacting NHS 111, the Siskin Centre and/or King's Lynn Access Centre. We have heard that this is often due to long wait times on the phone or there not being enough appointments available.

The reasons that people have been searching for an ongoing dentist have been varied. Reasons have included:

- e Recently moving to the area
- Their current dental practice turning private
- Their financial situation changing and no longer able to afford private treatment
- Having not visited a dentist in several years but now concerned they have pain.

Members of the public also told us they had tried to contact multiple dentists; several

Figure 1. A graph showing the number of dental enquiries between January and September 2020.




telling us they had contacted over 20 different dentists or dentists up to 40 miles from their home. Others told us how they had tried to find an NHS dentist for well over a year with no success.

Supporting evidence from our Insights and Intelligence Sub-Group

We have reported on Norfolk dental provision to our Insight and Intelligence Sub Group since February 2020; noting feedback our Engagement Team have collected from patients since November 2019.

From November 2019 - January 2020 we collected 14 reviews about dentists with an average rating of 2.8 out of five stars.



From February - April 2020 we collected 6 reviews about dentists with an average rating of 3.8 out of five stars.



From May - July 2020 we collected 11 reviews about dentists with an average rating of 3.5 out of five stars.



Other feedback presented to the Insight and Intelligence Sub Group about people's struggle to access NHS dentists included:

- At King's Lynn foodbank a member of the public told us: "I cannot smile as I hate my teeth but I cannot find a NHS dentist in King's Lynn. I can't afford private care. My teeth hurt and it affects my life but I can't do anything about it."
- At Breathe Easy in King's Lynn, members of the public told us they could not get an NHS dentist. Some of these people had been taking part in research projects for COPD, they told us the studies were showing that poor oral health can affect COPD.
- At JPUH we heard from a patient who had "tried to register but cannot get into a practice, recently needed treatment for a tooth abscess tried to get emergency dental appointment no luck. Then called 111 but they referred me to emergency



dentist that said they had no appointments so ended up going to A and E. I know this is not what I should do but I was in a severe amount of pain and was becoming unwell due to the infection."

- "Couldn't make an appointment. Tried over and over again to make an appointment through the automatic phone service between the stated times 8.00-9.00am." review of Kings Lynn Dental Access Centre
- "my boyfriend had an emergency at the weekend and this emergency dentist/line is not even open! [...] once he got through to the first person in the queue and the phone started ringing it has been ringing for over 5 mins and waited in the queue for 30 mins with no one answering! [...] He has been trying to get seen since Saturday morning and it is now Monday [...] Needless to say we never got an answer" - review of Kings Lynn Dental Access Centre
- I called 2 days in a row bang on at 8:30 the first day i got cut off after an hour and a half of waiting to then call back and it be fully booked. The second day I finally got through after 2 hours of waiting to be half way through giving my details to then be cut off again. No one even called me back even though I was finished giving my details" - review of Siskin Dental Centre
- After being in a queue for 4 hours, finally the phone started ringing as if they where going to answer but another hour went past still ringing, 5 hours wasted and didn't even get through, no one has time to sit around waiting for you to answer!" review of Siskin Dental Centre
- I do appreciate that it's a busy time for Siskin Dental practice, during the COVID-19 crisis. However I was recommended to call by the NHS 111 service and also had a call reference number, I was on the phone for nearly 3 hours, so I waited until I was first in the queue. The phone was now ringing so I was really hopeful that I would get through, but no after another half an hour I just loss the will to live, so hung up." - review of Siskin Dental Centre

However, the care at the emergency dentist is often praised by patients, for example the following review for King's Lynn Dental Access Centre:

I visited during covid 19 outbreak and I was so grateful to be seen by staff putting their own health at risk to treat me. All staff had full PPE and made me feel at ease straight away. They were all extremely friendly and cheerful as well as kind and caring when I had my tooth removed." - review of King's Lynn Dental Access Centre



In the Insight and Intelligence Report from February 2020 you can clearly see the rise in enquiries during January 2020 compared to enquiries we received last year.

See graph below showing the number of dental enquiries we have received between February 2019 - February 2020 based on Clinical Commissioning Group areas.




Figure 2. Graph taken from the February 2020 Insight and Intelligence Sub Group Report. This graph is displaying the number of dental enquiries HWN have received between February 2019 - February 2010 based on Clinical Commissioning Group areas. Please note February 2020 data is incomplete, but correct on 19th February 2020.

Investigations into dental services in Norfolk

Due to the concerns raised through our signposting log and service reviews, we decided we needed to do some investigations. This involved regularly calling dental surgeries across Norfolk and Waveney collecting information on whether the surgery was taking on new NHS patients.

We also kept a list of the surgeries able to provide urgent dental care to those not registered with a surgery. However, from March to August 2020, the only urgent or emergency dental services we were able to suggest contacting for the whole of Norfolk was based in Kings Lynn and Norwich.

We were not able to suggest any surgeries taking on new NHS patients from early July to mid-September.

We also looked at information on dentist's websites to see when they were last updated and if they were accepting NHS patients. (See tables below).

The tables below summarise an exercise carried out by Healthwatch Norfolk looking at 90 dentist websites stating when they were last updated and whether they were taking on new NHS patients.

From looking through the 90 dental practice websites, just over a third had not updated information for more than 50 days. Of the 59 which had updated their information, only two practices were taking on new NHS patients and 37 dental practices were only taking on NHS patients by referral of a practitioner.
