

Swan Lane Surgery Feedback

May 2024

In May 2024 we visited Swan Lane Surgery to speak with patients about their experience with this service. This doctor's surgery in South Norfolk is part of the Long Stratton Medical Partnership. From this visit we received 12 reviews for the practice. The reviews have an average star rating of 4.3 out of 5.

Healthwatch Norfolk Officers who visited Swan Lane Surgery noted:



The surgery has recently completed refurbishment of the waiting area and an extension which has resulted in a greater number of clinical rooms and a dedicated nursing wing. Parking spaces are planned to be increased although this work had not taken place at the time of our visit.

Overall, most patients we spoke to noted positive interactions with staff and awarded the service four or five stars out of five. The surgery was described as "the best place to be when you're ill" and "first class".

Some patients said they can get appointments when required however others told us it can be difficult to book in. A need for more disabled parking spaces was highlighted and this was acknowledged



on the day by the Practice Manager who told us more will be available once the car park renovation is complete. One patient let us know they are reluctant to engage with the service as they no longer trust their GP and have been unable to register with a different doctor.

Response from Wymondham Medical Partnership

We would like to thank our patients for the feedback received in the recent visit from Healthwatch. We have taken on board the points raised and will be taking action to correct where possible / necessary. As specific items were raised about car parking we can reassure our patients that our landlords have this in hand. New lines are going to be marked, the tarmac will be patched to improve the potholes, and there will be an extra disabled space added as requested.

We are very conscious that capacity and demand is an issue, and we are doing all that we can, within our financial constraints, to recruit and provide the best service to all of our patients. We have a lovely extended surgery here and, as our population grows, we will be able to look at expanding our clinical team with the funding generated.

This has ruined my life, I had to stop working and the cancer treatment was awful. I avoid coming here and use the hospital consultants instead although they've told me to see my GP to get antisickness tablets as I have side effects from a treatment I'm on. I can't deal with trying to get seen and I don't trust the doctor who missed my cancer. I asked to change GPs and was told to fill in a form and explain why which isn't right. I didn't do it as I'm fed up. If I could see the doctor my husband has then I'd come in and get the medication for my sickness. The nurse practitioners are very nice but they're not a very caring doctors.	1
