

School Lane Surgery Feedback



May 2025

In May we visited School Lane Surgery to speak with patients about their experience with health and social care services. From this visit we received 23 reviews for the service. The reviews have an average star rating of 4.3 out of 5.

School Lane Surgery is a GP practice located in Thetford. Upon their last inspection in January 2024, the surgery received a rating of 'Good', from the CQC. There are approximately 17,500 patients registered with the practice at this current time. School Lane Surgery offers a variety of services including Diabetic, Asthma, and COPD checks.



Healthwatch Norfolk Officers who visited School Lane Surgery noted:

Signage regarding opening hours is provided in Polish and Portuguese as well as English ensuring a wide range of patients can understand the information.

The waiting room is spacious with clearly defined areas for separate surgery and pharmacy queues.

A ramp is available at the entrance as an alternative to stairs which increases accessibility however, we observed a wheelchair user having difficulty climbing the internal staircase as there is no lift to first floor appointment rooms.

Overall, people appeared to be satisfied with the care they received from School Lane Surgery, specifically mentioning the friendly and caring attitudes of the staff as well as timely appointments. There were mixed opinions about accessing appointments, alongside issues with prescribing medications and the telephone booking system.

Provider response

We take on board all the feedback from the Pts from HealthWatch as well as other feedback from Friends and Family as well as other sources. We are redesigning our appointment system to improve access, reduced DNAs and align our current capacity with demand as much as we can. This will be phased in and fully up and running by the 30th June. Whilst no appointment system is ever perfect we feel that by moving to a same day request this will reduce DNA rates, improve access and reduce the waits on the phones that Patients are complaining are too long. We are also recruiting more GPs with one recently started, another starting at the end of June and two more hopefully due to start in Aug and Sept later this year.

They've said I can phone but the queue is very long. Also some of the doctors speak very quickly. I wish they'd speak louder and slower especially when they have strong accents as I'm hard of hearing.	4

I tried on the phone last week to book a face-to-face appointment as I had something that needed to be physically looked at, and I got a telephone appointment. You used to be able to book same day or urgent appointments online but that's only for non-urgent now. Also the surgery pharmacist was supposed to phone me which hasn't happened. I went to collect my medication and it had been changed without my knowledge or any doctor involvement, the doctor doesn't know why.	4
