

## Frailty Unit, Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital Feedback



## September 2025

In September 2025 we visited the frailty unit at Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital (NNUH) to speak with patients about their experience with health and social care services. From this visit we received 14 reviews for the unit. The reviews have an average star rating of 4.3 out of 5.

The Frailty unit makes up part of the NNUH. Upon their last inspection, in September and November 2023, the hospital received a rating of "requires improvement", from the CQC. The frailty unit offers a variety



of services including the older people's assessment service (OPAS) clinic, older people's emergency department (OPED) and the movement disorder clinic.

Healthwatch Norfolk Officers who visited the frailty unit noted:

- We observed clinical staff responding quickly to patients, dealing sensitively with those who were confused or distressed. We also saw friendly interactions between patients and cleaning staff – they knew patients' names and had evidently built a warm rapport.
- We were told the Frailty Hub responds to the needs of patients aged over 65 who score highly on the Clinical Frailty Scale. The Hub takes a multidisciplinary approach and aims for patients to return home, where possible, as quickly as possible due to the known recovery benefits of this. A Comprehensive Geriatric Assessment is conducted and care plans created accordingly, sometimes implementing use of the Virtual Ward.
- The Hub has close links with medical staff in the wider community including paramedics and Community Matrons.

Overall, people were happy with the care they received at the frailty unit at the NNUH. Many people reported that staff were kind and kept patients informed about their care. Lots of people also shared positive opinions about the food. However, a couple of responses mentioned inconsistency in care, with some staff not being gentle enough, or patients struggling to get staff attention when they needed help.



Below there is a graph that shows the key themes and feelings shared in the feedback collected by Healthwatch Norfolk.




Figure 1 - A graph depicting review themes and sentiment for the feedback collected from the Frailty Unit at NNUH by the Healthwatch Norfolk Engagement Team.
