

## Old Mill Surgery Feedback



## October 2025

In October 2025 we visited Old Mill Surgery to speak with patients about their experience with health and social care services. From this visit we received 12 reviews for the surgery. The reviews have an average star rating of 4.3 out of 5.

Old Mill Surgery is a GP surgery in the village of Poringland. The surgery offers a variety of services including asthma reviews, ear syringing and diabetic checks.

Healthwatch Norfolk Officers who visited Old Mill Surgery noted:

- Both sets of doors into the surgery are automated. The waiting area is bright with plenty of seating. The layout is accessible to patients who are wheelchair users due to its spacious design.
- There is an on-site dispensary.



 The car park is very large with multiple accessible spaces.

Overall, people were satisfied with the care they received at Old Mill Surgery. Many praised staff members, saying they were helpful and professional. However, there was mixed feedback regarding access to appointments. Some people reported being unable to book appointments in advance, not being able to book online and not being able to see a doctor.

Below there is a graph that shows the key themes and feelings shared in the feedback collected by Healthwatch Norfolk.




Figure 1 - A graph depicting review themes and sentiment for the feedback collected from Old Mill Surgery by the Healthwatch Norfolk Engagement Team

I rang and the ring back is brilliant, they come back to you within 10-15 minutes. I'm not happy about them going online for booking appointments but I think that's the whole NHS.  They seem to be alright.	4
112492	Old Mill Surgery	Have to chase things up	I had some medication prescribed and only half of it came through.  Also, it came through the post when I'd asked for it to be sent to Well.  I rang yesterday about it and have had to come in to chase again today - they've told me they need to get the missing bits prescribed again. Stuff like this does happen fairly regularly where I need to chase things and I don't know what I'd do if I couldn't get here. Also, I can't book an appointment through the app which I thought you could. Another thing that concerns me is that the PPG members all seem to be over 65 which isn't very representative. Maybe the surgery could do more to encourage other people to join? I feel like they still get you to see other people instead of the GPs. For example, I saw a paramedic and ended up having to also see a doctor anyway. In the main I'd rate it as 'good', it's not bad.	4

I've got an appointment in three weeks' time to discuss my medications and a few other things. I've been in today to see where my new medication is, as they'd told me it would be in the pharmacy a week ago. It's for my blood pressure, which is high at the moment, but I do have my old medications for now. They've said they'll send it over now. The nurses are usually quite helpful.	4
